**Loud and Quiet Bake Off!**



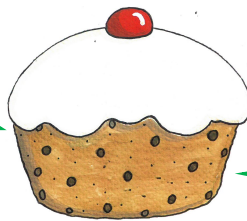
- ♪ Can you count the cakes in each row to a steady beat?

- ♪ Try tapping your counting with your hands or on a baking tray with a wooden spoon!
- ♪ Can you design you own big and small cakes to make a new pattern?
